The Development group invite tenders to Commission a local consultant to produce visual and audio material in the form of video, audio and photograph of the ongoing and conclusions of the above project. The applicant will be responsible to arrange workshops and group sessions to offer technical and creative skills such, as using digital cameras and film making. The results will become part of a display. A completed video envisaged would take 3 forms with Gaelic included in key headings

1. An explanation and recording of the project and all its aspects ongoing and completed.
2. An edited documentary of the historical and heritage of the area with particular reference to the history, the story of the school and its role in Scottish Education and
3. A reconstruction of the school in action.

The consultant will supply audio guide handsets to be issued to visitors with agreed recorded material, to allow the visitor flexibility in the order and speed at which they can follow the trail.

The finished work will become part of the outcomes of the project, display boards, exhibition, information leaflets and research documentation.

The person should be appropriately qualified and have practice in community projects and be able to work as part of a team. Written applications with CV and examples of relevant experience and tender should be with Graham Bruce, Schoolhouse Durness by midday Monday 10th August

The commission will involve about 27 days of work some dictated by the team.
